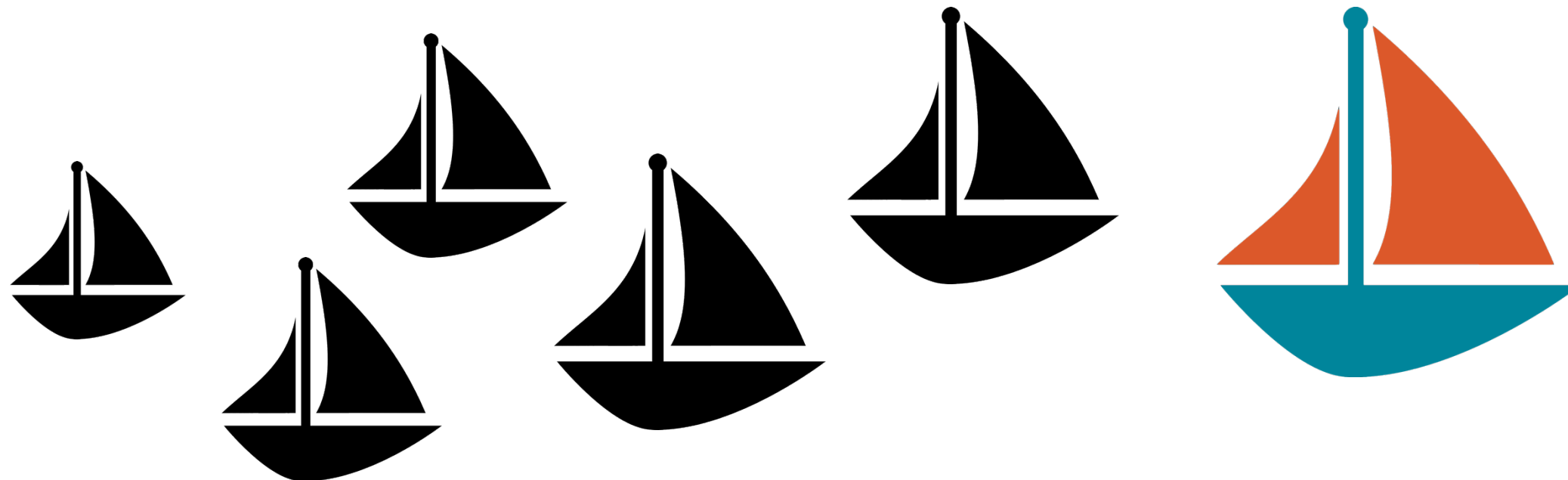

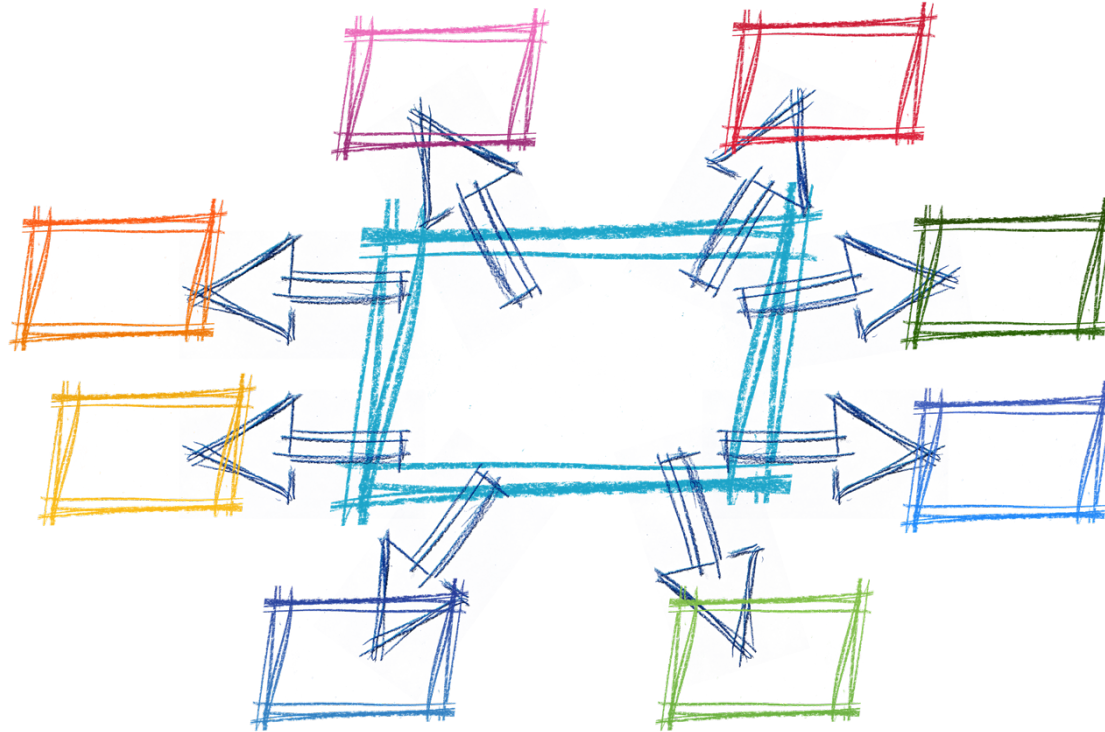

There Are Many Paths Of Evolution Possible

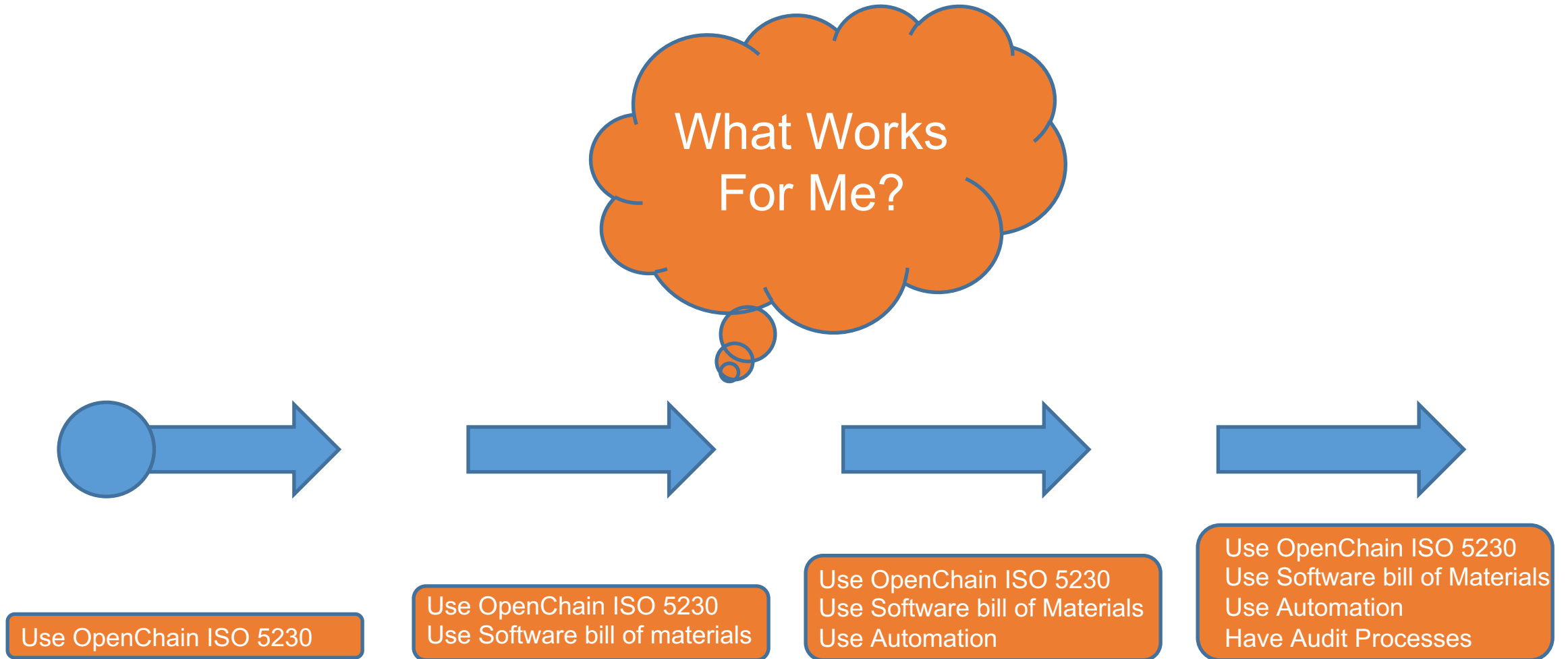


Choices depend on company size, organizational approach, and market sector
